Note 1: On Sunday, October 12th, after noon, a joint walk to the ruins of the Střekov Castle near the city center will be prepared for any interested participants.

Note 2: The city of Ústí nad Labem is located in the north of the Czech Republic, near the border with Germany, on the European road route E55 connecting Prague and Dresden.

The nearest airports are Prague or Dresden, both of these cities are also connected by international express trains, and Ústí nad Labem is roughly halfway between Prague and Dresden.

If you don't know them yet, both cities are definitely worth a visit.

Note 3: Please arrange your own accommodation in Ústí nad Labem. We recommend the Clarion Hotel in the city centre (https://www.clarioncongresshotelustinadlabem.com/en/).

Note 4: You can travel around the city by public transport, buses or trolleybuses. At most stops, you must board through the front door with the driver, and the fare can be paid using a common payment card.
